- Establishment of a regional network in the field of bioeconomics
- Good practices in bio-economy at national and regional level
- Analyzing and evaluating the R & D potential in Bioeconomic field
- Database containing the appropriate components
- The potential of bioeconomy research in Romania and Oltenia Region

The workshop was attended by members of the academic and business community, representatives of regional and local public authorities, interested in setting the priority directions to be funded by different types of instruments meant to support intelligence specialization fields in Romania.

During the presentations, Gabriel Vladut included a brief description of **Made in Danube Project**, goals, achievements, facilities for Stakeholders and next steps.

Gabriel Vladut presented the definition, the role and the 9 steps of Technology Readiness Levels (TRL), role of the technological transfer on bioeconomy, a common methodology for Technology Offer, Technology Request, Innovation Audit, Brokerage events, in Danube region.
